The Fund is provided by HSBC Global Asset Management Limited (HGAM) which are accessed via a Trustee Investment Plan provided by HSBC Life (UK) Limited. The Trustee Investment Plan is an investment wrapper used within the HSBC Flexible Retirement Account. The Investments held within the HSBC Flexible Retirement Account will be made via the Trustee Investment Plan. The HSBC World Selection Adventurous Fund invests 100% in the HSBC World Selection Adventurous Portfolio. The fund mirrors the objective used by the portfolio and associated investment allocations which are both described below. All investment decisions are made by HSBC Global Asset Management Limited.

Fund objective

The Portfolio aims to provide capital growth through investment in a range of asset classes across global markets with a bias towards asset classes that focus on equity investment strategies. The Portfolio will invest primarily in collective investment schemes that in turn invest in equities, fixed income securities, property and derivatives.
